Sorghum Prairie Pearls™ Seed & Plugs

Growing Information

- Plant after last frost date until Mid-Late June in Northern Climates
 - Similar culture/temperature requirements to Corn & Sorghum
- Sow 10 seeds per linear meter in rows (3 seeds per linear foot)
 - Keep 50cm spacing between rows (20 inches between rows)
- Medium to low Moisture and Fertilizer required
 - In general, sorghum is very tolerant of drought and low fertilization
 - When too high nitrogen is present in the soil, the plants will become more vegetative and delay flowering
- Plant in full sun/open field
 - High light intensity improves color on the grains/inflorescence
- Sow to flowering, ~50-60 days
- Seed head formation
 - Green seed heads ~70-80 days
 - Colored seed heads ~80-90 days
- Note, we are still learning about full culture and timing will depend on grower's environment. Current recommendations based on trials in Western Texas.
